<b>Contextual Information</b>	<p>St Luke's Catholic Primary School, Woodvale, is a double stream primary school comprised of 505 students from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6 serving the Woodvale Parish Community.</p> <p>The school is situated on a coastal plain, 7 kilometres from the Indian Ocean and 17 kilometres north of the City of Perth.
